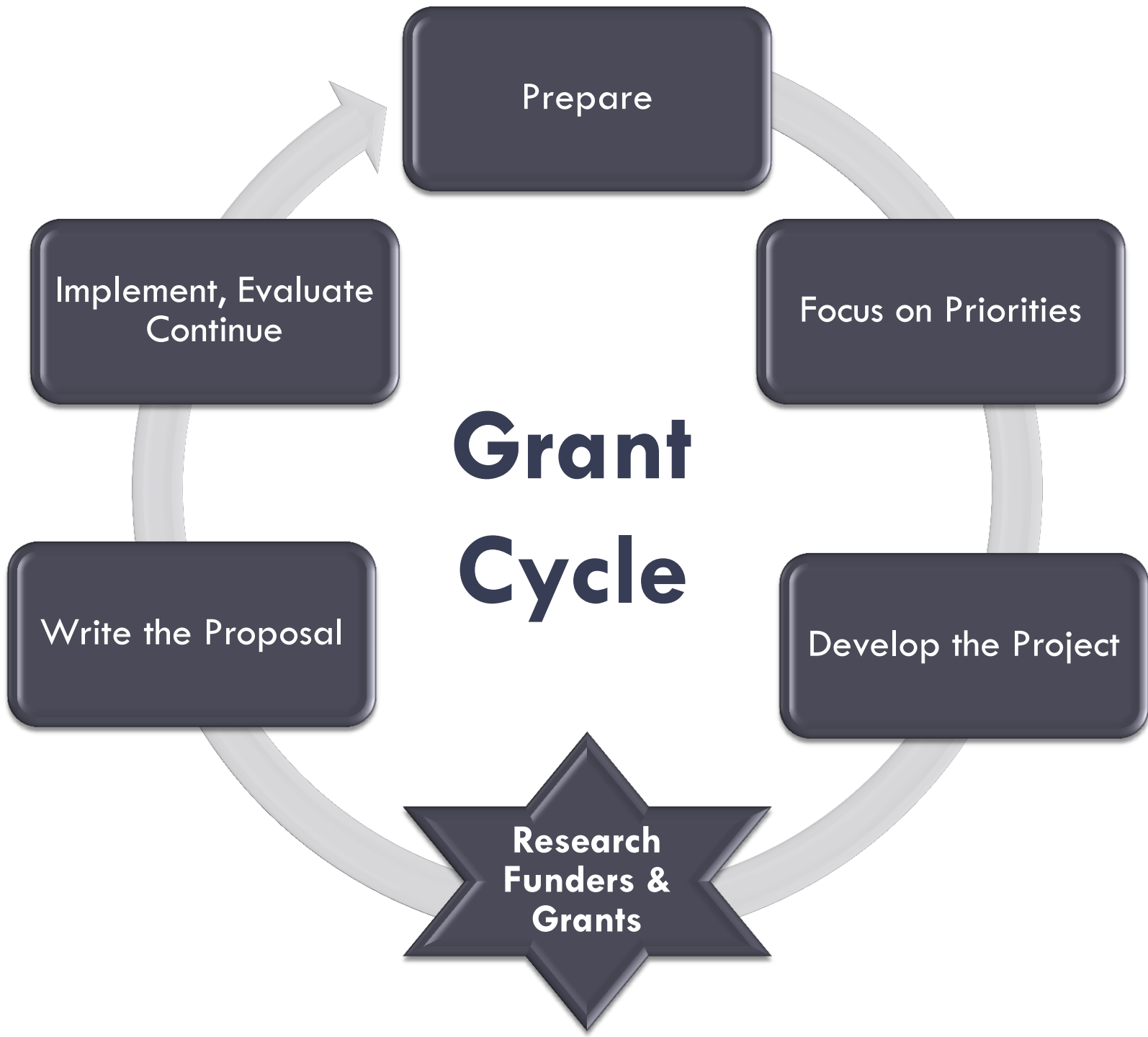

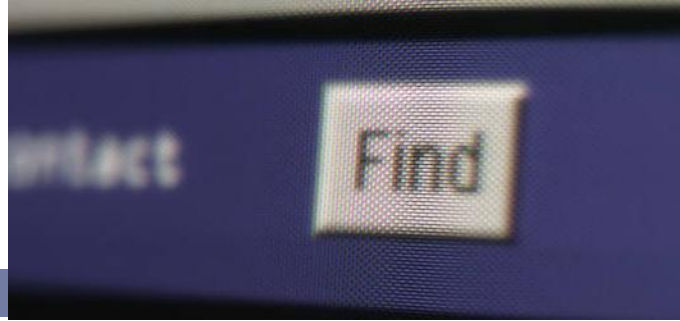

Search Tips



- **Translate your project into the language of the resources and funders**
 - key words, subject matter, geographic area, target audience, gender, race, and any parameters that fit
 - Refine and target your search, work from general to specific
- **Learn all about prospective grantors** to find a good match!
- **Visit prospective grantor websites**
 - annual reports, success stories of previous grants, staff biographies, current guidelines.
- Nonprofit Intelligence: Guidestar.org; search on 990s
- Record what you find; Keep your research organized

Learning About Funders



- **Basic Information:** name, address, contact information; background of key people (officers, donors, staff, trustees)
- **Grantmaking Philosophy/Program Emphasis:** grant history; mission; program interests, population focus, geographic focus, types of support provided.
- **Financial Information.** Assets/market value; contributions reported in past; range of grants and typical grant size.
- **Application Process.** Application guidelines; application forms/common proposal format; initial approach; deadlines; meeting dates.

FIND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

All discretionary grants offered by the [26 federal grant-making agencies](#) can be found on Grants.gov.

You do not have to register with Grants.gov to *find* grant opportunities. However, once you are ready to *apply* for a grant, you will need to [Get Registered](#). This process takes 3-5 business days up to 4 weeks if you experience any difficulties.

Search Grant Opportunities

Search by keyword, Funding Opportunity Number (*FON*) or Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number.

Basic Search >>

Search by a variety of categories of funding activities.

Browse by Category >>

Search from a list of agencies offering grant opportunities.

Browse by Agency >>

Search by more specific criteria such as: Funding Instrument Type, Eligibility or Sub-agency.

Advanced Search >>

Search for Recovery Act Opportunities.

Find Recovery Act Opportunities >>

Once you have found the grant opportunity for which you wish to apply by entering a specific search criteria, click the "Application" button in the grant opportunity synopsis.
